4. For the **romanization** of words from Eastern Asian languages, authors should use:

- Pinyin for Chinese,
- Revised Romanization of Korean for Korean (established in 2000)
https://www.korean.go.kr/front_eng/roman/roman_01.do
- Hepburn for Japanese.

5. **Spacing and Hyphenation:**

- For fluent reading, romanized East Asian words in more than three or four syllables should be divided into smaller semantic units.

- Romanized postpositions should be treated as a single word.

ex) Hyeol **ui** nu, Nihon kenkyū **to** bunka kenkyū, Zhongguo **de** wenhua

6. **Old Manuscripts**

- A source from part of an old manuscript directly quoted in the main text is clarified in a footnote as shown below.

Ex.

- *Analects* 2.7, *Mencius* 6B.8,
- “Wangzhi 王制,” in *Liji* 禮記 (Book of Rites).
- “何謂人情，喜怒哀懼愛惡欲，七子佛學而能” (“Liyun 禮運” [The Conveyance of Rites], in *Liji* [Book of Rites]). All translations of the Chinese classics in the article are mine, if not otherwise noted.
- “喜怒哀樂之未發謂之中，發而皆中節謂之和” (*Zongyong*, ch. 1).

7. When historical figure(s) and state(s) are first mentioned, provide their dates in parenthesis as follows: Zhu Xi 朱熹 (1130-1200), Han 漢 (206 BCE-220 CE).

8. To quote a passage in pre-modern Chinese texts, put the English translation in the body and the original Chinese text in the footnote.

12. Reference

- References should be listed in alphabetical order of the authors' surnames.
- Editor(s)
Ariga, Mitsutoyo, ed 1955. *Ariga san no Jiseki to Omoide* 有賀さんの事蹟と思い出 (The Achievements and Memories of Mr. Ariga) Tokyo: Dō Hensankai.
- If multiple reference materials by a particular author are listed, the titles should appear in chronological order in the reference list. For publications by the same author in the same year, they should be listed in alphabetical order by title, with a lowercase letter after the year of publication.
Ex.
Choe, So Young. 1995a. *Examining Ancient*
———. 1995b. *Trends in...*
- A source in a foreign language should appear in its romanized/original titles, with translation if available or needed.
Hu, Pingsheng. 1999. *Xiaojing Yizhu* 孝經譯註 (Interpretation and Annotation of the Book of Filial Piety). Beijing: Zhonghua shuju.
- A Chapter in an Edited Book
Szanton, David. 2002. "Introduction: The Origin, Nature and Challenges of the Area Studies in the United States." In *The Politics of Knowledge: Area Studies and Disciplines*, edited by David Szanton, 2-22. Berkeley: University of California Press.
- Translated Books
